### Psalm 1:2

An Expanded Bible Study

The second verse of Psalms chapter one tells of the mindset a godly person should have: But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate both day and night.

We see in verse one how a man is blessed by not taking advice from those who do not know the mind of Christ, or those who position themselves like the world (striving for the same goals/in the same world like manner) or posture a defying, ridiculing manner.

In verse two the word ‘but’ is understood as “never the less, or on the other hand.” Further, ‘his delight is in the law of the Lord,’ literally means this person receives great pleasure by knowing the law of God.

The second part of verse two is understood in the context of Judaism. Early in the life a Jewish boy, he is taken to the synagogue to observe the recitations and prayers of his father, Jewish teachers, and rabbis. Daily devotions and scripture readings are rituals woven deep into the fabric of his life. During the period of Old Testament history, Jewish rabbis and young scholars studied the law, spending hours each day in scripture memorization. In the life of a Jewish boy, the law becomes something that continually stayed on his mind. Scriptures are not just read from the Torah at the synagogue, only later to be forgotten, but are talked about throughout the day until well into the evening.

Today, we understand God's laws as His precepts or statutes, which guide our Christian walk. So, what is the psalmist saying in verse two? Plainly, the psalmist is saying that our **contentment and satisfaction** comes in knowing the laws and ways of God. When we spend time studying God's word, we have a spiritual map into the very heart and mind of God.
